

NEW: Summer Courses for Young Adults in Bournemouth

Bournemouth is an attractive and exciting seaside town with one of Britain's cleanest and most popular sandy beaches. The mild climate and fine summer weather make for a great outdoor holiday experience.

Although it is situated on the south coast, it is within easy reach of many historic and cultural sites and only 2.5 hour drive from London. It's a busy cosmopolitan town with great shopping facilities and live entertainment.

Our Young Adults school

Our young adult's school is based directly in the town centre opposite the Tourist Information Centre. In peak season additional classrooms might be used in the Bournemouth & Poole College, in the Lansdowne.

Accommodation and Meal Plan

Students will stay in single en-suite rooms in Glendevon Hotel, just a short walk away from the city centre and 2 minutes to the sandy beach. Rooms for major and minor students are strictly separated. Major students can use a fully equipped kitchen. For minor students, there are microwave, fridge and kettle available.

Young Adults Summer Programme

Our young adults programme is suitable for independent mature-minded students. Students have the freedom to explore Bournemouth on their own. There is no supervision but our English-speaking IP Guide is available if problems arise. Of course, the counsellor will give students all the necessary information in a Welcome-Meeting and a Town Walk. He will also organize a visit to a disco once a week and offer additional trips and activities on request which are not included in the package.
