## Centre description

We welcome your students to the Youth Hostel Diez!

Diez is a small, picturesque town in Rhineland-Palatinate. The camp takes place in a modern and completely renovated youth hostel high above the Lahn, in the historic and romantic earl's castle. The youth hostel offers a café, table soccer, flipper, table tennis and a playground. A public coin-operated telephone is available as well as a snack and drink machine. From the castle you can take a small path leading to the idyllic town, where you will discover shops and cafés. The "Lahnwiesen", an area of green meadows on the banks of the river, is also within easy reach. You are accommodated in multi-bedded rooms with en-suite shower and toilet facilities. Bedclothes are provided, but you have to bring towels with you.

In peak season we have up to 50 students in the centre. Students mainly come from Germany and France but also from other countries from all over the world. That means that our students will enjoy a multicultural environment with German as the main language of communication. Some activities are also run in English and French as we welcome German students (having English or French lessons) in the centre as well.

A large choice of activities is offered in the afternoon and evenings. Of course, students are under the permanent supervision of our International Team (normally, one supervisor is responsible for 15 students). Further information about the Team Members and the languages that are spoken by the Team are available prior to departure.

## How to get to Diez?

- By flight: On request, airport transfer is provided. On the day of arrival our Meet & Greet-Service welcomes each student at the airport and ensures a safe transfer to the Centre. On the day of departure, we will take you to the check-in desk. Meet & Greet Service and transfer are offered from Frankfurt International Airport.
- By train: Diez has got its own railway station. The train takes 30 min from Frankfurt Main station. On your arrival in Diez we will meet you at the train station.

## Campus - Youth hostel Diez

### Situation

- In an historic castle
- Situated on a mountain overlooking the town

- Large refectory in the residence

## Residential Accommodation

- Multi-bedded rooms (3 - 6 bedded rooms) en suite.
- Students will share a room with peers of the same sex. If possible, they will also share a room with students speaking another native language (unless they request to stay with a friend), but please bear in mind, that this may not always be practical.
- Rooms are lockable and there is one key-card per room
- Big cupboards, lockable
- Bedding is provided and changed weekly
- Cleaning of rooms daily
- Public phone booths are in the centre
- Plug adaptor is necessary for international students
- Safe available in the centre reception.
- Students are not allowed to leave the campus without at least one member of staff
- Deposit: 50 €



## Meal plan

All students enjoy a full board meal service in the refectory. Vegetarian options provided.

- Breakfast: 08.00 - 8.45 (continental breakfast)
  - Lunch: 12.30 - 13.30 (warm dishes)
  - Dinner: 18.00 - 19.00 (cold dishes)
- (Buffet, students clear their own table)

## Lessons

- Take place in the residence
- **Test** on the 1<sup>st</sup> day
- **Certificate** at the end of the course
- **Courses available:** Intensive German Course (20 lessons per week)
- All our courses follow the European Framework of reference levels
- **Levels on offer:** beginner (AO), elementary (A1), lower intermediate, intermediate (B1), upper intermediate (B2).
- There are no more than **15 students** in one learning group. Normally, these students are of different mother tongue and of nearly the same age.
- All teachers are **native speakers** and are experienced teaching their mother language to foreign students.
- **Lesson times:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> lesson: 9.00-10.30; Break: 10.30-11.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> lesson: 11.00-12.30.
- **Beginners:** 04.07. and 18.07.09. Minimum stay 2 weeks

## Supervision

Our friendly and helpful **International Team** with staff members from England, Germany, France, or other countries will run a fully supervised activity programme and guarantee supervision.

There is one supervisor responsible for 10 students (10 - 14 years). The members of our team have been carefully selected for their responsible and caring attitude and for being fun-loving and outgoing. They are the people your students can turn to at any time for assistance.
