Frankfurt lies on the banks of the River Main and is the centre of Europe's economy and currency. Once a vital inland port and centre of trade, it is now Europe's largest financial centre after London. For many, Frankfurt is a metropolis of skyscrapers, called "Mainhattan".

A closer look reveals a city of many charms; the houses are picturesque and many houses in the city centre have been restored. The unique 'Museum Mile' along the banks of the river is a delightful area to take a stroll and sample some of the delicious local food and drinks.

- German language tuition (20 lessons of 45 minutes per week) in mixed nationality classes where possible
