

Junior Summer Courses in Oberwesel (Rhine Valley)

The Rhine Valley is one of Germany's most popular and beautiful regions. Our centre is located in the romantic town of Oberwesel on the banks of the Rhine, close to the famous Loreley. Oberwesel is perfect for younger students. It's a small, safe, and pretty town, which offers all of the necessary amenities. Narrow streets with their beautiful medieval houses, towers, and churches guarantee a fantastic stay in Germany. Oberwesel is a short distance from several famous places such as Koblenz, Bingen, Ruedesheim, and just a 1hr drive from Frankfurt and its international airport.



Campus: Castle Schönburg

Our summer school can be found in the historical castle Schönburg, just a 15 minute walk away from the town centre, located on a hilltop overlooking the river Rhine and town of Oberwesel.

Campus Facilities

- Traditional classrooms in the residence, some equipped with TV and Video
- Large dining hall in the residence
- IP Ocean Lounge: meeting point for our students
- Internet in the ocean
- Outdoor barbecue area on campus
- Sport facilities for soccer, handball, volleyball and basketball in town (just a 15 minute walk away)
- Table tennis in the residence

- Half-day trips to St. Goar, Ruedesheim, Bingen or Boppard
- Full-day trips to Mainz, Cologne, Cochem or Trier

What's included?

- Full-board residential accommodation in multi-bedded rooms (2-4 students) with communal or en-suite toilet and shower facilities on campus
- Full-board accommodation in twin rooms, with one of our local home stay hosts with packed lunches
- German or English language tuition (20 lessons of 45 minutes per week) mixed nationality classes where possible
- Maximum 15 students per class
- Course material
- Placement test on arrival
- Certificate at the end of the course
- Supervised activity programme
- 2 half-day trips and one full-day trip per fortnight
- One half-day trip and one full-day trip for every additional week

What's not included?

- Airport transfers (available from Frankfurt International and Frankfurt-Hahn airports), railway station transfers (from Koblenz station)
