Biarritz, Anglet and Bayonne make up the glamorous Côte Basque, ideally situated in South West France. Alongside Paris and the French Riviera, Biarritz is one of the three most attractive holiday destinations in France and the area offers a wide choice of daytime holiday activities.

Bayonne is a medieval town with great shopping facilities and a beautiful riverside-setting, while Biarritz is a vibrant cosmopolitan town with magnificent beaches, golf courses and numerous sporting facilities. The wonderful beaches are a surfer's paradise.

Destinations	Description
Sare	Located on the Spanish border, it's known as one of the most beautiful villages in France. Sare is a village of the Pyrenees-Atlantiques, in the region of New-Aquitaine . In the heart of the Basque country, the village is surrounded by the Pyrenees mountains. Its traditional houses, pelota court, majestic church of St Martin with three floors of oak galleries and unspoilt environment are all attractions that add to the charm of the area. Our tour will follow the route from St Martin to Maison Ihartze Artéa, where we will enjoy the view from the magnificent mountains, then continue to the Town Hall and enjoy a final glimpse of the prehistoric caves.
Saint Jean de Luz	Located on the Atlantic coast, just a few kilometres from Spain, Saint-Jean-de-Luz's wealth stems from its port and its past, with the town being associated with either fishing or from the capture of vessels by its own Basque corsaires, or pirates. The town features a large number of residences built in the 17th and 18th centuries along the Quai de L'Infante, Rue Mazarin, Rue Gambetta and at the Place Louis XIV. We will enjoy the view of those in our guided tour among other relevant places in this city.

Destinations	Description
Lourdes	Lourdes is a small market town lying in the foothills of the Pyrenees. It is part of the Hautes-Pyrénées department in the Occitanie region in southwestern France. Prior to the mid-19th century, the town was best known for the Château fort de Lourdes, a fortified castle that rises up from a rocky escarpment at its centre. In 1858 Lourdes rose to prominence in France and abroad due to the Marian apparitions claimed to have been seen by the peasant girl Bernadette Soubirous, who was later canonized. Shortly thereafter the city with the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes became one of the world's most important sites of pilgrimage and religious tourism.
San Sebastian	San Sebastián or Donostia is a coastal city and municipality located in the Basque Autonomous Community, Spain. It lies on the coast of the Bay of Biscay, 20 km (12 miles) from the French border. San Sebastián has three beaches, Concha, Ondarreta, and Zurriola, and is surrounded by hilly areas, so you can enjoy magnificent views from the coastline. Framed by golden beaches and lush hillsides, San Sebastián has undeniable allure, from its venerable dining scene to its grand architecture and packed cultural calendar.
Pau	Capital of the Béarn department in the Aquitaine region, Pau is an old royal city beautifully set between the mountains and the ocean, at the extreme southwest tip of France. It is heir to a rich tradition of tourism dating back to the 19th century, when it was a prestigious resort for aristocrats from around the world.
